
Instructions for using your Journey Wheel Niddy Noddy or Mini-Noddy


Your take-apart Niddy-Noddy (2 yards) or Mini-Noddy (1 yard) is made of solid cherry with brass rings at the center of each arm. It is designed to travel easily and to help measure and skein your finished yarn. Its gracious curves follow the lines of a beautiful *circa* 1800 niddy-noddy.


Putting it together...

There are 3 pieces to your Niddy-Noddy: a central stem and a pair of arms. Insert the stem into the brass ring at the bottom of each arm (Mini-Noddy note: about 1/16" of the stem will show on the other side of each arm). Gently but

firmly twist the arms into 90° opposition as shown.







Winding on / Measuring ...

Loop one end of your yarn over an upward curving arm (A above) facing you as you hold the central stem in one hand. With this arm facing you, wind your yarn over the arm to the lower left (B), then up and over the other upper arm (C) behind the central stem, then down under the other lower arm (D) on the right, then up to your starting point.

This distance — once around points A-B-C-D — equals two yards on the Niddy-Noddy, and one yard on the Mini-Noddy. To remove your skein, tie it in2-3 places with a short piece of contrasting yarn, and then slide your skein off the downward curving arm.
